# Pendleton Country Club - Golf Course Policies

*These policies are designed to assure a quality and fun golfing experience to all members and guests of Pendleton Country Club. Please help by following these policies and encouraging others to also do so.*

- All Golfers must check in at the Pro-Shop prior to teeing off.
  
  - Pace of Play: All groups must play the course in a total of four hours, (2-hours per nine holes). Groups playing at this pace or faster are considered to be on time and should not feel rushed or encouraged to let other groups play through.
  
  - All groups must tee off the front nine unless approved by the pro shop. No groups may tee off the back nine before 10am due to maintenance needs.
  
  - Foursomes always have the right of way on the golf course.
  
  - Fivesomes will be allowed by only under the following circumstances:
    - During slow times on weekdays and weekends.
    - After being approved by the Pro-Shop Staff.
    - Must play to the PCC Pace of Play Policy.
  
  - Groups larger than five will only be allowed under the following circumstances:
    - Months November through February.
    - At non-busy times.
    - After being approved by the Pro Shop Staff.
  
  - Course Weekly Schedule
    - Monday: The course is closed until noon for maintenance, (April – October).
    - Wednesday: Scheduled Men's Game at Noon year-round.
    - Thursday: Scheduled morning Ladies Game, (April – October).
    - Friday: Junior Day in mornings, (June – August).
  
  - Non-Member Play: Non-members may play any day after 12:00pm. Residents of Umatilla County may play as a guest during member hours and receive guest rates only three times per year. After playing three times, residents will be limited to playing after 12:00pm and paying normal outside rates.
  
  - Driving Range Hours: The driving range will be closed at 3pm each Sunday in the months March through October. This allows the range to be picked and mowed each week.
